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## Rules For Fabulous Adventures

1. Adventure with exploring eyes and curious minds
2. Talk about what we discover but don't interrogate or lecture
3. No worksheets allowed. If we have our eyes on a piece of paper, we won't see what's around us
4. Adventures are all about being free to try new things and experiences – or not – without any pressure. Kids don't have to get involved with all parts of an adventure
5. No follow-up assignments are allowed. Required work kills curiosity. It spoils an adventurous day.
6. But it's okay to strew things later to extend the adventure as long as kids are free to accept or reject what we have to offer.
7. Focus on the enjoyment of the experience and being with each other. That's the best and most important part of an adventure.
